■ **Patent 62,090.** (See page 123) This pattern, in black as an underglaze pattern on rolled edge Lamber-ton China, is shown and listed in the 1928 Pick-Barth catalog as “Washington” pattern.

■ **Patent 69,312.** Designed by G. Ellis. Issued Jan. 26, 1926. (See page 132.)

AKA “Atlantic Pattern.” Some pieces are backstamped with “Atlantic Pattern” “Design Patented.”
